Maple Systems U.S. Dodd Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act Statement

The U.S. Dodd Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act Section 1502 exempt Maple Systems as we are not considered a “contract to manufacture”. We are classified as an “issuer” as our involvement with the product is limited to the following actions:

1. We affix our brand / logo / labels to generic products manufactured by a third party.
2. We repair product manufactured by a third party.

Maple Systems is not a “contract to manufacture” as we do not influence the materials, parts or components in the products and thereby are excluded and exempt from the U.S. Dodd Frank Wall Street Reform and Consumer Protection Act Final Rule as cited in the Securities and Exchange Commission 17CFR.
